  - o One Fish (1st Grade) will not take the swim test at the pool. They will swim in age appropriate areas.
  - Campers in other groups may take the swim test if they want to swim in the deep end
  - If a camper does not pass the swim test they can only stay in areas that they can touch.
    - They can retake it swim test every Wednesday
  - We will record the campers who have passed the swim test if they are returning week to week
- Campers need to come to camp with <u>bathing suits on with a cover up</u>, flip flops are optional.
- Pack sunscreen with name written on it
- Pack a towel, closed toe shoes, change of clothes and underwear
  - Campers will change when they return to camp

**Parent Information:** Welcome to Camp Odyssey@ WDS. We are at this location for the month of July. We are excited to work with your camper and make lasting memories. Here are a few pieces of information to help our families.

8:30-3:30 is the regular camp day

7:30-5:30 includes early drop off and after camp (this is an additional cost)

#### Just a reminder...

- Masks are not mandatory but are optional.
- 7:30-9am Drop Off Parents will pull up to the first set of double doors, we will have staff out
  front who will help unload your camper from the car. Parents are not permitted into the building.
  - Early Drop Off (Extended Care) starts at 7:30am (which is an additional cost)
  - o Regular Drop off is from 8:30am to 9am
- Opening Skit for theme days starts at 9am
- Regular dismissal begins at 3:25pm to 3:45pm
  - You can stay in your car and pull up close to the sidewalk in a single line
  - We will come to you with a clipboard to sign out your camper and we will call them to come out to your car.
- If a Camp Odyssey camper has a younger sibling at WDS Day Care, you may park but please sign your camper out on the clipboard at the Camp Odyssey (first set of double doors)
- After camp is from 3:45pm to 5:30pm (which is an additional cost)
  - Please park and walk up to the first set of double doors
  - A staff member will meet you and call your child for dismissal.

**SNOWIE BUS** Every Tuesday Snowie Bus arrives at 2:30 for WDS kids and campers to purchase a shaved ice treat. If your camper is interested it costs \$2. Please put the money in a zip locked bag with your camper's name on it.



Everyday campers need water bottles, a snack and lunch. We do NOT provide lunches.

#### Refund/Payment Policy

- After June 1, **no refund** will be made because of withdrawal, suspension or absence from camp. Payments lost due to the above cannot be applied to the next year's program or a sibling.
- Campers may add additional programs at any time with full payment of fees received by the Thursday prior to program beginning.
- Substitutions or changes must be made before the first day of any program.
- Changes in programs once a program has been registered for will require a \$10 processing fee.
- Campers who are picked up late after 5:30pm continuously will be charged a late fee of \$15 per day.
